

WIOA Youth Program Eligibility

16-24 and not attending any school AND at least one barrier below:

- School dropout
- Not attending school for at least most recent school year calendar quarter
- An individual with a disability
- Pregnant or parenting
- Subject to juvenile or adult justice system
- In or aged out of foster care
- Homeless, runaway
- Eligible for Social Security Disability
- In Out-of-home placement
- A low income recipient of a secondary school diploma or its equivalent who is basic skills deficient or an English language learner
- A low income individual who Requires Additional Assistance to enter or complete an educational program or to secure and hold employment (as defined by Resolution on June 17, 2015 by the FLWIB, Inc.)

'Requires Additional Assistance' can be;

1. An individual who has not held employment with the same employer for more than one year (poor work history)
2. An individual at risk of substance abuse
3. An underemployed, out of school youth
4. A non-custodial parent
5. A veteran of US foreign services
6. A victim of physical/sexual/domestic violence (DV)
